



Apple Jack

Pie dough

Apples

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup brown sugar

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup white sugar

cinnamon

$\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon nutmeg

1 cup raisins

2 tablespoons lemon juice

- Spread half the pie dough on a jelly roll pan.
- Slice apples in a large bowl, add remaining ingredients and stir.
- Arrange apples on pan and drizzle juice from bowl over apples evenly.
- Put crust on top.
- Bake at 375 for 1 hour.
- Spread icing on top when cool.

This looks like a variation of the Apple Slices with Currants recipe that precedes it. Another one of those miraculous recipes that gives some very specific measurements and some vary vague amounts - "pie dough" ??? "apples" ??? "Icing" ??? Bless Mom's heart...what size pan does this make???
